University of New Mexico Hospital (UNMH) has submitted an Authority-to-Construct Permit Modification Application (#0953-M2) to the Air Quality Division (Division) of the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health Department to install two (2) 2206 hp diesel fired emergency generators. The facility is located at 2211 Lomas Blvd NE, in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Approval of the modification to the existing air quality permit is required before operations can increase in Bernalillo County.
